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RACIAL ENROLLMENT Who is in your school?


KEY

- More than 99% black, Hispanic, and/or Asian enrollment
- 1- More than 90% black, Hispanic, and/or Asian enrollment
- More than 70% white enrollment with less than 10% of one other race represented
- Two races represented at 10% or more (including white enrollment)
- 1- Three races represented at 10% or more (including white enrollment)
- Three races represented at 10% or more AND 20%-80% Free/Reduced Lunch eligible







OUTCOME: Over 30 students from 12 districts (representing over 18,000 young people in schools across NYC) have accepted nominations as youth delegates. Last month, they took their first action in generating a social media campaign. This month, they will write letters to their public officials inviting them to join our movement.



HOW CAN YOU HELP?
