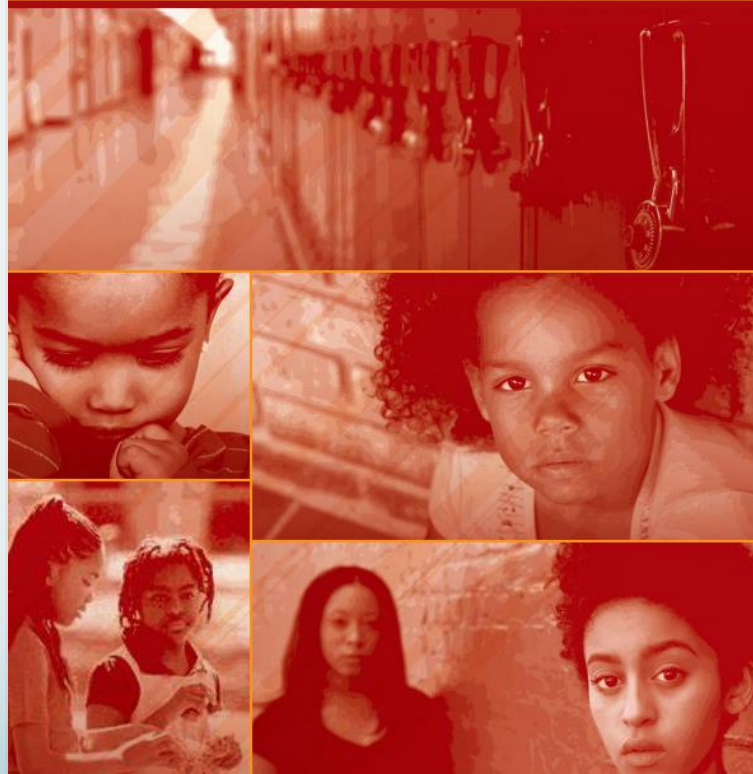
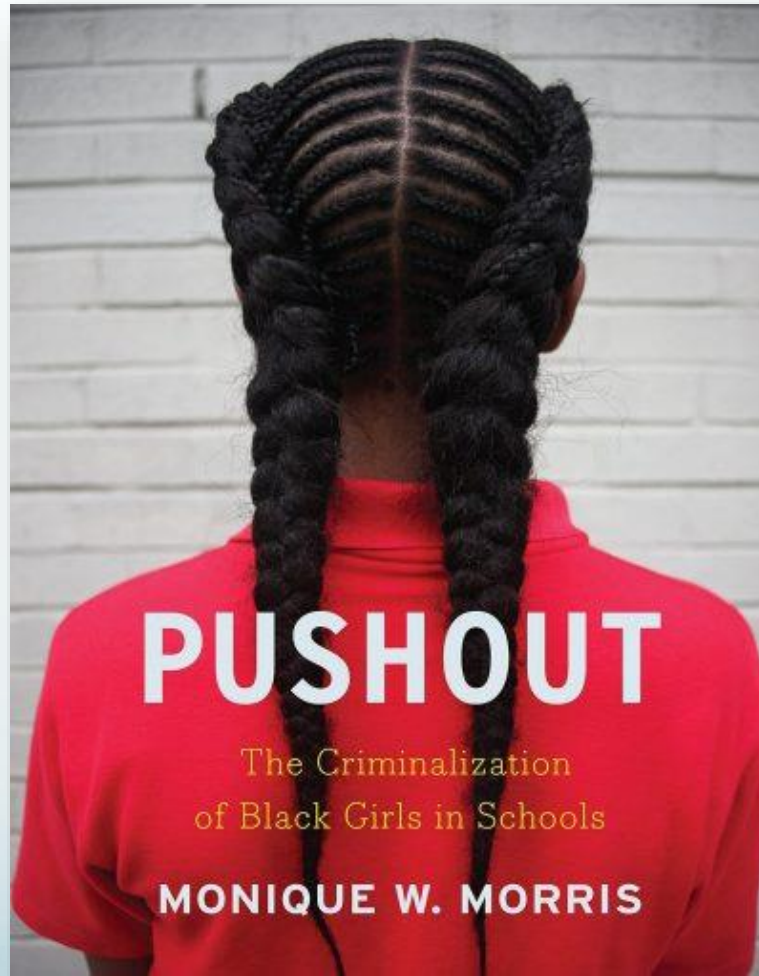

While the threat and overuse of suspensions hurts all students, Black girls and boys are disproportionately impacted.

ACCORDING TO THE MOST RECENT DATA FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, NATIONALLY BLACK GIRLS WERE SUSPENDED SIX TIMES MORE THAN WHITE GIRLS.
